## WSQ Mentoring Programme:

### **Building a system to support mentoring for novice and student teachers**

#### **Course objectives**

This WSQ mentoring programme is to enable learners to acquire the knowledge and skills to manage student teacher practicum/ attachments and guide novice teachers. The programme also enables learners to acquire the knowledge and skills in providing the structure and systems in ensuring successful mentoring programmes for novice and student teachers.

Topics include:

- Matching Mentor to Mentees
- Types of Tones in the Mentor-Mentee Relationship
- Liaise with staff from the early childhood services and from training organisations
- Managing orientation and induction procedures for staff and student teachers
- Providing support to supervisory staff and student teachers during practicum/attachment

#### **Target Audience**

This unit of study is appropriate for people wishing to enter the field of Early Childhood Education or for those already working in the field with job titles such as supervisor, principal, vice-principal, senior teacher, curriculum head and level head.

Taking the Preschool Qualification and Accreditation Committee's (PQAC) requirements into consideration, it would be assumed that learners with the above job titles possess at least a Diploma in Preschool Teaching for this level-5 course (CS-SP-512E-1).

#### **Duration:**

39 Classroom hours of Learning Circles (13 sessions of three hours per session) and at least 3 hours of Workplace Assessment.
